25 Chairman Arave opened the meeting at 3:30 p.m.

27 **DISCUSSION REGARDING DISTRICT COVID-19 REGULATIONS POST PUBLIC**
28 **HEALTH ORDER AND MASK MANDATE EXPIRATION**

30 Mr. Miller reported that there had been some erroneous information released but that the
31 conditions of HB 294 and their benchmarks have not been met. Mr. Blakesly provided some
32 clarification and added that HB 294 prevents a statewide mandate unless a public health order is
33 issued by the County Health Department and ratified by the County Executive body. Mr.
34 Blakesly added that employees can be required to wear masks but for the public they can be
35 encouraged but not required.

37 A discussion was had on what the Health Department might do, School Districts being
38 exempt for the time being, the District's limitations for classes and public sessions, and different
39 concerns and options on requiring District employees to wear masks. As this was a discussion
40 item, and not an action item, Board Members expressed they would allow Mr. Miller to enact
41 safety precautions as needed for the District's employees.
