**POSITION REPORTS TO:** Aquatics & Fitness Director, Aquatic Operations & Program Managers

**GENERAL PURPOSE:**

Under the direction of the Aquatics & Fitness Director, help ensure the safety and supervision of the patrons in and around the Aquatic areas of the Recreation Center.

**EXAMPLE of DUTIES:**

1. Responsible for performing Lifeguard duties in an effective manner
  - a. Supervise the conduct of patrons to prevent and/or correct unsafe conditions and behavior
  - b. Strictly and tactfully enforce rules, regulations, policies, and ordinances governing the conduct of patrons using the Facility
  - c. Respond to accidents or situations in or out of the water and provide first aid, CPR, and other assistance as necessary
  - d. Participate in the record keeping of accidents, rescues, and water chemistry
  - e. Help keep the Recreation Center clean and uncluttered
  - f. Help maintain pool areas by putting in/taking out lane lines, cleaning decks, and removing all unnecessary equipment from the pool areas
  - g. Report unsafe conditions to the appropriate personnel in a timely manner
2. Assume responsibility for maintaining positive relations with patrons
  - a. Conduct oneself in a professional manner and be dressed in proper uniform
  - b. Assist and support patrons in a positive and productive manner
  - c. Respond to questions and/or concerns of patrons in a prompt fashion
  - d. Handle rule violators tactfully
3. Responsible for establishing and maintaining effective working relations with personnel and management
  - a. Attend all staff meetings and in-service training sessions
  - b. Assist other lifeguards and area personnel as necessary
  - c. Stay aware of the other lifeguard chairs and areas of responsibility
  - d. Provide input for Aquatic area planning
  - e. Discuss areas of concern with appropriate personnel
4. Other duties as assigned

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. At least 15 years of age

2. Currently certified in American Red Cross Waterpark Lifeguarding, First Aid, CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer (r. 17)
3. Ability to pass a Center prepared water test
4. Ability to communicate effectively with patrons, supervisors, and other employees
5. Alert, attentive, and responsible
6. Ability to work effectively as a team

**WORKING CONDITIONS:**

1. Willing and available to work early mornings, mid-day, evenings, weekends, and holidays
2. Moderate physical activity including pushing, pulling, and lifting medium weights
3. Uncomfortable working positions such as stooping, crouching, and bending
4. May have a few disagreeable elements such as noise, poor ventilation, or extreme or uneven temperatures
5. Work inside and outside
6. Exposure to stressful situations as a result of human behavior
7. Exposure to cleaning and pool maintenance chemicals, blood, fecal matter, vomit, or other bodily fluids
